

# Hobbs Middle School

## **Parent/Student Information: What do we do now?**

1. Students can store their gear in a locked room upstairs (above the locker rooms) during the day. **ALL GEAR SHOULD BE CLEARLY LABELED.**
2. We encourage water-resistant clothing. Beginning students especially may fall down frequently. Note that while jeans may be stylish, they don't dry quickly. It is miserable to be wet and cold on the mountain. We recommend layers, warm socks, hats, & gloves. **LABEL YOUR STUFF!**
3. Students/Parents can **bring equipment and gear to the school between 7:30-7:50am** each Thursday to store in the locked room upstairs. This will be available **ONLY BETWEEN 7:30-7:50am.** *There will not be faculty available to unlock that room after 7:50am.*
4. Students will be excused from their 7<sup>th</sup> hour class 30 minutes early to load the bus.
5. If parents can't bring gear before school, they need to bring it to the student before they board the bus. ( 2:30 pm.)
6. **Kelly Canyon will not allow any broken, faulty, or plastic skis or snowboards** on the mountain (for liability reasons). If students bring equipment that doesn't meet Kelly Canyon standards (i.e. all snowboards must have leashes), or if their equipment breaks while on the mountain, they will have to RENT equipment. *The rental fee will be collected from the parents BEFORE the next trip. The student will not be able to go with the Ski Club until the fee is paid.*
7. **Make sure your equipment is in good repair, fits, and is adequately adjusted.** Kelly Canyon will not adjust or repair personal equipment.
8. If you are renting equipment – please **know your shoe size.**
9. Students will be given lift tickets BEFORE getting off the bus. Those renting equipment will be given their rental form and go with their chaperones to the rental shop to get their equipment.
10. All students will go with chaperones to check in at ski school for lessons.
11. After lessons, students will have free-time on the mountain to practice what they have learned. **We encourage students to bring food from home or money for the snack bar—they will be hungry!** There will be an area in the lodge set aside for Hobbs Middle School.
12. Students should not leave electronics (i-pods, video games, cell phones) on the bus or in the lodge. **Neither Kelly Canyon nor Hobbs Middle School is responsible for lost or stolen items.**
13. Students will load the bus at 8:00 pm to return home. **They should be home about 9:15. Please be prompt when picking up your child.**
14. **Parents should note that any student who refuses to comply with instructor, chaperone, or bus driver requests, or behaves in a defiant or belligerent manner, forfeits their right to ski club—no refunds will be issued in this case.**
